It has been a busy time for the Navy Training Corps' cadets from TS Bulldog, based at the Kingsway Community Centre. As well as taking part in the annual Water Bourne Weekend at Waterland cadets they have been sailing at Croft Farm in Tewkesbury and later this month they will be hosting the annual Trafalgar Day Parade.

Twelve cadets from TS Bulldog joined almost fifty cadets from other units for the water borne adventure. The cadets camped at the site and took part in canoeing, kayaking, wind surfing and sailing as well as making and then racing their own rafts. The cadets used a variety of nautical skills, not least their abilities with ropes and knots to make sure that their rafts both floated and stayed together.



As well as water borne activities the cadets take part in a variety of activities such as field craft, cooking, seamanship, target shooting, parades, and first aid.

We take cadets from 8 to 18 years of age.

The unit meets at Kingsway Community Centre on Monday nights between 1845 and 2100.
